Music and Media Internship Summary

The Minister of Music and Media Intern is primarily responsible for aiding the Music and Media Minister in the vision, direction, and oversight of two essential ministries; music and media. These five areas of responsibility are:

- 1) Plan and lead worship services alongside the Music and Media Minister.
- 2) Support the Music and Media Minister in recruiting and developing the music and media teams.
- 3) Foster a culture of musical excellence and theological faithfulness in our worship ministries.
- 4) Meet with the Music and Media Minister for vocational and discipleship purposes.
- 5) Support The Hallows Church Music and Media ministry in other areas as needed.

This minister will also participate and collaborate in future projects pertaining to contextualized creativity and church growth efforts. A passionate, musically-skilled, future-oriented, organized person will succeed in this role.

Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities Required for this Role

- Some experience in leading musical worship in a church is preferred.
- Strong musical skills, including the ability to plan, teach, and arrange songs and set lists.
- Relational approach to ministry and a willingness to collaborate with others.
- Must be a self-starter who can independently manage multiple projects, priorities, and deadlines.
- Values collaboration and interdependence amongst staff and leadership teams.

- Growing faith in and dependence upon Christ.
- A love for sharing the Gospel in word and deed.
- Able to joyfully embrace our “one church; three expressions” identity and philosophy.
- Commitment to our church Passion, Process, and Core Values.
- Embraces and operates within our philosophy of ministry.
- A hunger to grow spiritually, musically, and professionally.
